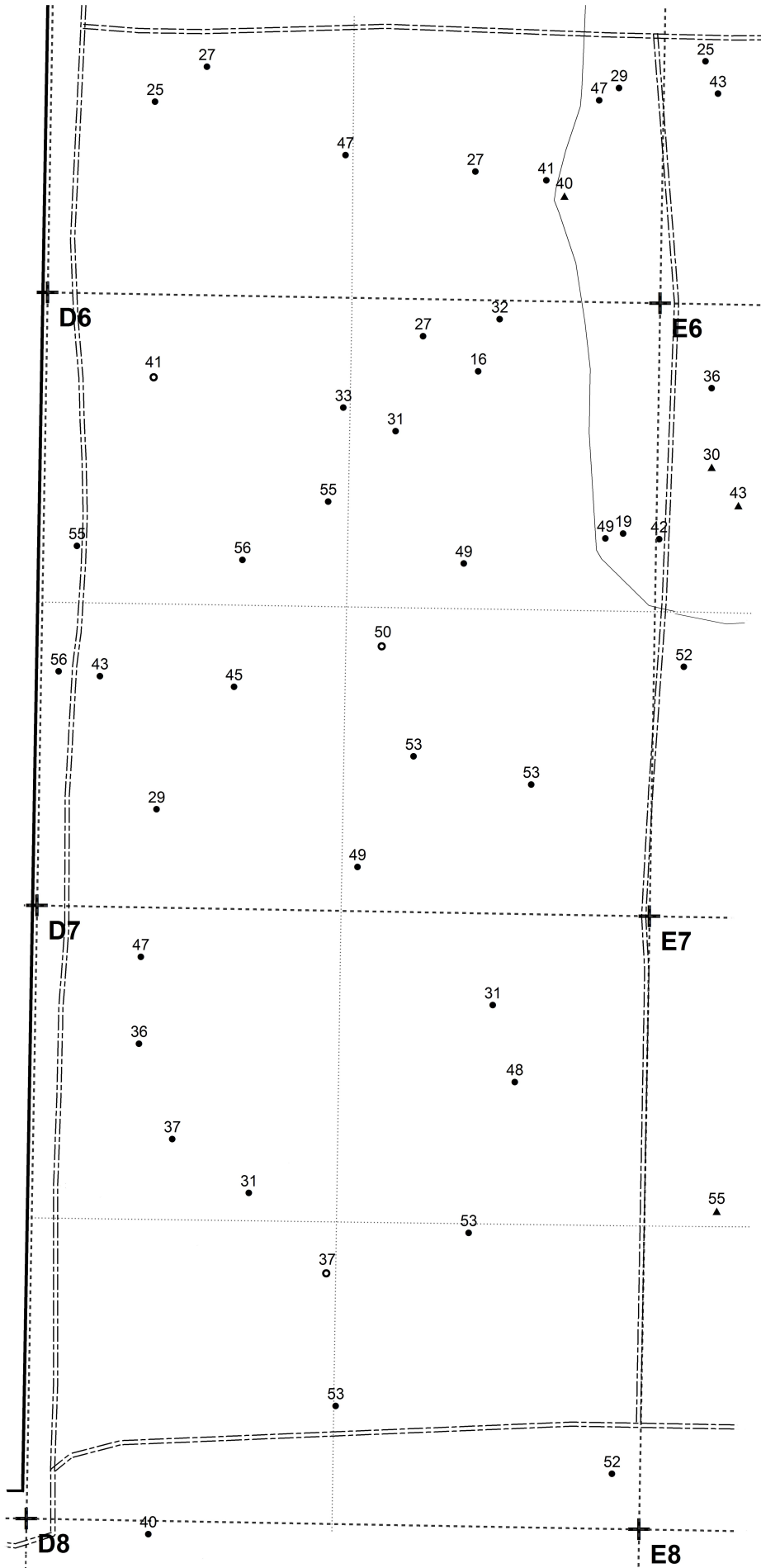


# Pines and grid map of Block B of NATL's Upland Pine Ecosystem

Numbers are diameters (DBH) in centimeters as measured in 2008. Trees last censused in March 2013.

This block was formerly known as sPAP (south Public Area Pine).

**Grid blocks:** Each 50x50m *grid block* is defined by a *grid stake* at each corner and is named after the stake in its NW corner. On this map each grid block is divided into a NW, NE, SE, and SW 25x25m “quarter grid block.” The grid stakes are at permanently surveyed points. The other three corners of each ¼ grid block may be marked with temporary stakes that were located by measuring from the surveyed points.
