Pignut hickory

Carya glabra (Juglandaceae)



Identification: Compound leaves with 5-7 leaflets; hairless dark yellow-green leaves; thin, dark grey bark

Notes: The most abundant hickory in North America; releases large quantities of pollen in the spring and causes hayfever; excellent fuel wood
