Cutleaf Evening Primrose



Description: native; blooms from late spring to early fall; flowers open at night and close when hit by strong sunlight; seeds are eaten by Bobwhite Quail, Mourning Doves and other birds

Family: Onagraceae **Scientific name**: Oenothera laciniata
