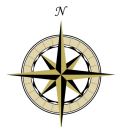
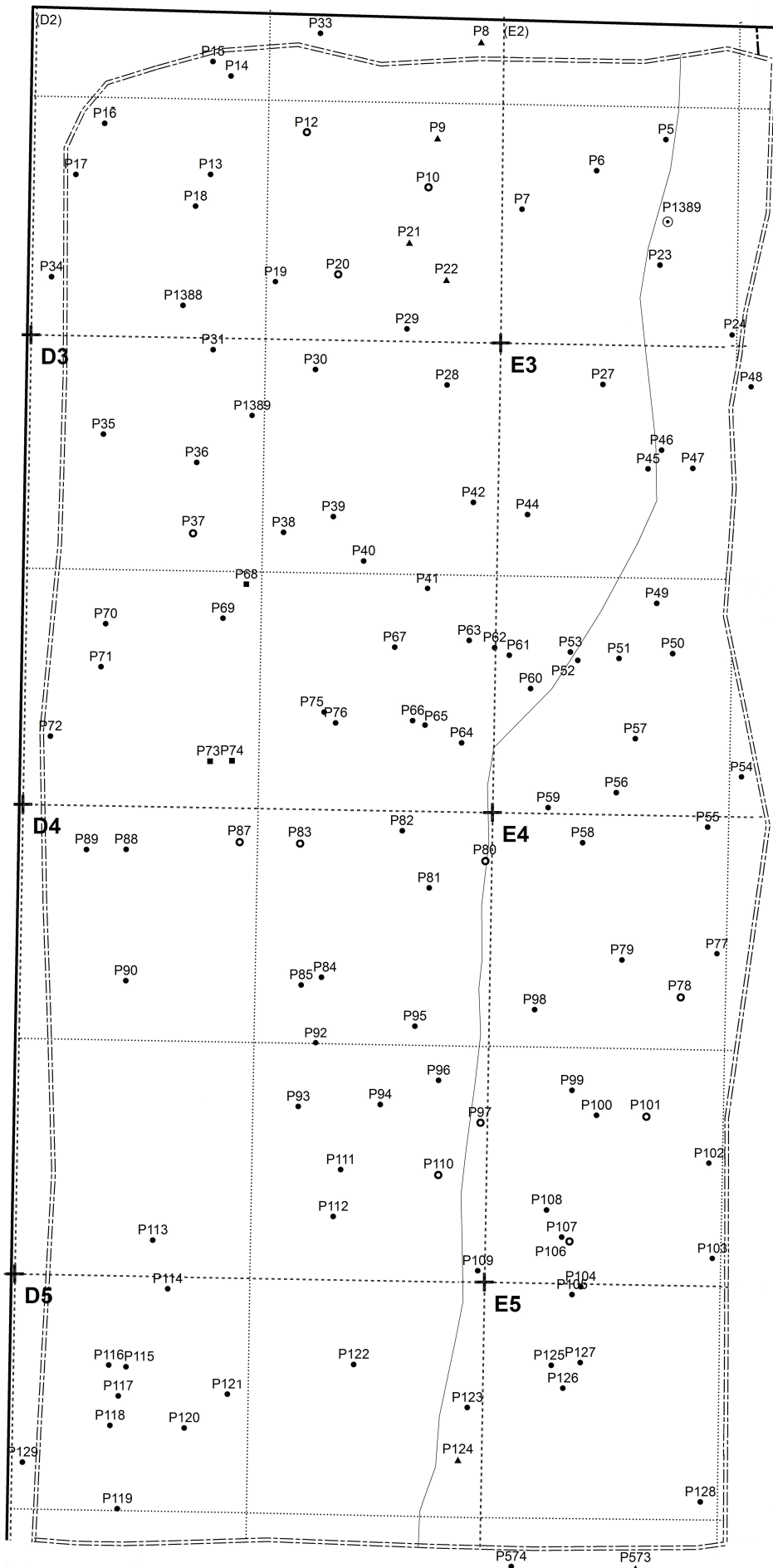


Identifying numbers of pines in Block A of NATL's Upland Pine

This map shows the "P-number" for each of its pine trees.

Grid blocks: Each 50x50m grid block is defined by a grid stake at each corner and is named after the stake in its NW corner. On this map each grid block is divided into a NW, NE, SE, and SW 25x25m "quarter grid block." The grid stakes are at permanently surveyed points. The other three corners of each ¼ grid block may be marked with temporary stakes that were located by measuring from the surveyed points.
